

### Attachment C

### **Insurance Requirements**

To commence work and receive compensation pursuant to the Contract, Contractor shall demonstrate that it has in effect insurance sufficient to satisfy, at a minimum, the requirements stated below and shall maintain such insurance until its obligations under the Contract have been discharged. These insurance requirements are not intended to limit the indemnity provisions of this Contract and the BOCC does not warrant that these minimum limits are sufficient to protect Contractor from liabilities that might arise out of the performance of this Contract. All insurance required by this Attachment C shall be issued by companies authorized to do business in the state of Colorado and written on forms satisfactory to, filed with and approved by the Colorado Department of Insurance.

## Commercial General Liability- Occurrence Form

The policy shall be endorsed to include the following additional insured language: "Garfield County, Colorado, its elected officials, trustees, employees, agents, and volunteers" shall be named as an "Additional Insured" with respect to liability arising out of the activities performed by, or on behalf of the Contractor."

**Automobile Liability** (can be waived if the Contract does not involve use of motor vehicle) Bodily Injury and Property Damage for any owned, hired, and non-owned vehicles used in the performance of this Contract.

### Worker's Compensation and Employers' Liability

Minimum Limits:

Coverage A (Workers' Compensation)
Coverage B (Employers Liability)
\$100,000/\$100,000/\$500,000

Statutory

Professional Liability (Errors and Omissions Liability) (applies only if Contract requires the services of a licensed professional).

The policy shall cover professional misconduct or lack of ordinary skill for professional services required by this Contract. If the professional liability insurance is written on a claims-made basis, Contractor warrants that any retroactive date under the policy shall precede the effective date of this Contract and that either continuous coverage will be maintained or an extended discovery period will be exercised for a period of two (2) years beginning at the time work under this Contract is completed.
